Engineering Honors Award
Travel Grants for Engineering Honors Students**

Eligibility and Criteria:

- Engineering Honors students may apply for up to \$1000 in funding to be used for academic travel
- Must have a major in the College of Engineering & Applied Science and be making satisfactory progress towards that major.
- Students must have a minimum UW cumulative GPA of 3.5 at the time of application.
- Incomplete applications will not be approved.
- Funding is only available for UW-approved travel (may include study abroad, national student exchange, professional conferences)
- Applications must be submitted no later than 60 days prior to travel.
- Acceptance of funds obligates the recipient to:
 - deliver to the College Dean's office a report on the travel experience within one month of return to UW
 - participate in a service project related to the experience

Include with your application:

1. A one-page statement of purpose documenting what you expect to gain from your proposed travel. You should address efforts that you have made to prepare for your travel, including foreign language training, your financial contribution, and other preparations for this opportunity. Include information about previous travel, study, work abroad, conference participation, if any.
2. A complete budget for travel, including how funds will be used (include airfare, ground transportation, lodging, conference registration, etc.)
3. If you will be taking courses, a one-page description of the intended program of study, including prospective courses and how those courses fit into your long term academic and professional plans.
4. A copy of a current, unofficial transcript (printed from WyoWeb).
