WWAMI RESIDENCY GUIDELINES

- A. The following U.S. citizens or permanent residents shall be classified as Wyoming residents for WWAMI purposes:
 - 1. Individuals age 18 or older, or emancipated persons under age 18, or the parents of said persons who:
 - a) maintain a domicile in Wyoming

AND

- b) have permanently resided in Wyoming for five continuous years immediately prior to the beginning date of the professional program.
- 2. Persons or their parents who have had legal residence in Wyoming for a minimum of one year

AND

are temporarily absent from Wyoming due to military service, attendance at an educational institution as a non-resident student, or other types of documented temporary absence,

AND

who have maintained ties to Wyoming proving domicile during their absence from the state,

AND

who have maintained such domicile for five continuous years immediately prior to the beginning date of the professional program.

B. All other persons shall be classified as non-residents for WWAMI purposes. Residing in Wyoming primarily as a student does not support a claim for resident status irrespective of the length of such temporary residence.
