

## **DISC GOLF RULES**

## 1. RULES AND REGULATIONS

- a.) Do not play the course alone. Spot all shots around blind corners and where pedestrians could be in the way. Spotting means a player is in the target area ready to knock down a disc headed for trouble.
- b.) Do not climb trees or buildings to retrieve lost discs. A disc stuck in a tree 6 ½ feet above the ground is a one (1) stroke penalty.
- c.) Hitting a building before hitting the ground is a two (2) stroke penalty.
- d.) Hitting a vehicle before hitting the ground is a one (1) stroke penalty.
- e.) Play only the designated course. Do not make up additional holes.
- f.) Players are responsible for any damage they may cause while playing this course. All damage is to be reported immediately to the Director of the University Physical Plant (phone 766-2266.)
- g.) Be courteous to others using the course. Discs should **NOT** be thrown when pedestrians are within the potential flight path of your disc. The University of Wyoming reserves the right to terminate the use of this Disc Golf Course or limit who may use it at any time.
