- 1 WHEREAS, on Nov. 13 2014, the UW Board of Trustees passed a resolution to create an
- 2 Endowed Chairs Initiative to create new endowed professorships; and
- 3 WHEREAS, the purpose of the Endowed Chairs Initiative is understood to be to raise the profile
- 4 of UW's colleges and departments by attracting new top-flight faculty and retaining current top-
- 5 flight faculty; and
- 6 WHEREAS, any initiative proposed to increase the profile and build the excellence of the
- 7 University must benefit its students, including its undergraduate students;
- 8 THEREFORE, be it resolved that a minimum percentage of 25% of endowed professorships be
- 9 granted to existing faculty; and
- 10 THEREFORE, be further it resolved that endowed professorship hires recruited from outside the
- 11 university be selected for their proven ability to collaborate productively with other faculty
- 12 members; and
- 13 THEREFORE, be it further resolved that endowed professorship hires be held to the expectation
- 14 that the university will see benefit proportional to the increased salaries paid to them; and
- 15 THEREFORE; be it further resolved that endowed professorships be hired for programs that
- 16 demonstrate moderate to high levels of student demand; and
- 17 THEREFORE; be it further resolved that every endowed professorship hire be required to teach
- 18 one undergraduate class (or equivalent undergraduate student-directed contribution) every
- 19 academic year.
