


Student Room Types



First Year Housing – Best Practices

	Small scale communities of 20 to 30 aggregated into larger buildings
FLOOR	Primarily double rooms, with some singles
FLOOK	Community bathrooms on a hallway
	Common study and lounge space throughout upper residential levels
	A rich complement of common spaces on the first level, including academic functions
BUILDING	Distributed student and professional staff, including faculty-in-residence programs
	Proximity to outdoor gathering areas (small and large, to accommodate the entire class)
DISTRICT	Intentional dining experience
	Located near the campus academic core
CAMPUS	Located near student life and student services facilities
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	Strong connection to campus open space
