

- Chosen concept for other connecting streets








PUBLIC MEETING RESULTS

- Public Safety Response






FINAL CONCEPTUAL DESIGN IVINSON AVENUE




Parking Gain/Loss: -11






FINAL CONCEPTUAL DESIGN IVINSON AVENUE





FINAL CONCEPTUAL DESIGN 10TH – 14TH CROSS STREETS






FINAL CONCEPTUAL DESIGN 13TH STREET












