The historian gathers material pertaining to activities and achievements of both the group and its individual members. This material should be organized and attractively displayed in a large loose-leaf notebook or three-ring binder. The following are suggestions of desired materials:

1. Newspaper clippings pertaining to the club or local community
2. Copies of programs of events in which the club or its members participated
3. Specially prepared summaries and lists including the yearly program of work, officers, committees, activities, prizes, awards, trips, tours, and camps
4. Photos of individuals and groups

5. Certificates or thank you's sent to the club
6. Any other materials having a bearing on club activities and progress



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
