## **CONTEST CLASSES & JUDGING**

Judging classes for the contest will consist of the following categories:

6 Wool Classes (50 points per class):

*Wool Classes, Possible Points = 300*

6 Sets of Questions/answers on each of the placing classes (2 points per question)

*Questions, Possible Points = 300*

Grading Line (15 fleeces)

*Grading, Possible Points = 225*

*Total possible points for the contest (all three categories) is 825*

Contestants will be allowed 10 minutes for each judging class and 25 minutes for the Fleece Grading Line.

The 4-H Wool Judging Placings & Questions Card will be used for all judging classes. The Wool Grading Line Form will be used for the fleece classes. Cards and forms will be provided by the State 4-H Office.
