CLASSES

Up to eight (8) classes of produce will be evaluated and contestants will have a maximum of 10 minutes per class. Youth may handle the vegetables but if a product is damaged, it needs to be addressed with the contest officials.

IDENTIFICATION LINE

The latest revision of the "4-H Produce Identification List" will be the authority to determine which products are used for identification. Youth will have 20 minutes for the identification line. Seniors will identify 30 products; Juniors and Intermediates will identify 20.

Scoring will be based on properly identifying vegetables by either the general classifications or the specific variety correct for that item. Deductions will not be made for spelling errors.

REASONS & QUESTIONS

Contestants will give reasons and/or answer questions on specific classes based on their age category.

Juniors: 3 questions classes with use of notes

Intermediates: 2 questions classes with use of notes and 1 set of oral reasons

Seniors: 3 sets of oral reasons
