Contest Entry

- There is no limit on the number of youth a county may enter.
- All contestants must submit an online entry form found at <http://www.uwyo.edu/4-h/youth/contests/fashionrevue/index.html>
 - ****Note any preferred times and/or conflicts you have on Thursday or Friday.****
 - Once the schedule is posted, changes cannot be guaranteed.
- Contestant eligibility will be verified using 4H Online.
- A contestant may enter each class (Constructed-to-Wear and/or Ready-to-Wear) one time. A separate entry form must be completed for each class.

Contest Rules

- Outfits/Garments being modeled must be wearable clothing.
- Undergarments may not be modeled.
- Contestant participation is required in the following:
 - Model judging at a specified time on Thursday or Friday
 - Fashion Revue practice on Friday
 - Public show on Friday
 - Each contestant only models once during the public show.
- A separate set of judges will be used for each *age* division.
- Exhibit judging at the State Fair in Ft. Caspar is optional and will not influence placing in the Fashion Revue modeling contest.
 - *Contestants do NOT need to enter an exhibit in Ft. Caspar to participate in any part of the Fashion Revue.*
 - If the outfit to be modeled is also entered to be judged in Ft. Caspar, each youth is responsible for checking clothes in/out for model judging.

Helpful Information for Contest Preparation

All activities will take place at the Douglas High School. Each contestant is responsible for his/her own transportation as well as credentials to get on and off the State Fairgrounds.

Model Judging

- If your garment is also being judged in Ft. Caspar, you can pick it up for model judging beginning Wednesday afternoon.
 - **NOTE:** Contestants are responsible for picking up and returning their own garments for model judging on Thursday and Friday. Please stop by the office in Ft. Caspar to let them know when you are taking and/or returning a garment.
- Contestants will have the opportunity to model for a panel of judges which will be followed by a short interview.

Public Fashion Revue

- Practice will begin at 5:00 p.m. on Friday afternoon.
- The show begins at 7:00 p.m. on Friday evening and awards will be presented at the conclusion of the show.
- The stage is equipped with professional lighting - please wear appropriate undergarments.
- Because there will not be time to go back to the Fairgrounds, bring your entire ensemble with you to the practice on Friday afternoon.
- Dressing rooms are available for show preparation.
