Successful completion of the 2+2 plan requires that a student remain continuously enrolled and graduate with the associate's degree from his or her respective community college. • This is a guide for course work in the major; actual course sequence may vary by student. Please refer to the online student degree evaluation. • Not all courses are offered every semester and some electives may have prerequisites. Students should review the course descriptions in the catalogs of their respective institutions and consult with their academic advisor to plan accordingly. • Academic plans and course schedules may need to be altered if ACT or Math Placement scores require a student to take pre-college courses (e.g., MATH 0900, 0921, or 0925) before taking required math or English courses.

Central Wyoming College requirements:

In order to graduate, students must successfully complete a minimum of 60 credit hours, with a minimum of 15 of the final 30 degree credits from Central Wyoming College. • All courses must be college-level courses as indicated by a number of 1000 or above. • A cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or better is required in all hours completed at CWC and in those courses required for graduation in a student's prescribed program. • A minimum of 2.0 (C) is required in general education course requirements and program requirements in the student's program of study. • An S/U graded course will not accepted to fulfill a general education or program requirement unless the course is offered S/U only.

University of Wyoming requirements:

Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 to graduate. • Students must complete 42 hours of upper division (3000-level or above) coursework, 30 of which must be from the University of Wyoming. • Courses must be taken for a letter grade unless offered only for S/U.

IW College of Arts and Sciences requirements:

Students must take two "core" courses in addition to UW's University Studies Program requirements: Diversity in the United States (ASD) and Global Awareness (ASG). • No more than 60 hours in the major subject may be used toward the 120 credit hours required for graduation. • At least 30 hours in the major subject must be completed with a grade of C or better (the major may require more).

CWC Art Program Notes:

- Students are encouraged to select a course that also fulfills UW's College of A&S Core Global Awareness or Diversity in the US requirement.
- Consult with an advisor for list of approved electives.

For the BA in Art, all students are required to take Portfolio Review (ART 2000), a one-semester course in which work is created based on the content and principles learned in the foundation core classes. The course is offered every semester, including summer sessions online. If taken in the summer before starting at UW, a student could begin his or her upper division art studio requirements in the fall rather than the spring semester.

UW Art Program Notes:

The Bachelor of Arts (BA) in Art requires a minimum 2.5 cumulative UW GPA and a minimum 2.5 GPA within the major to graduate. • Fifty-nine (59) semester hours in the major are required, comprised of the following:

* A **single language** must be taken for two (2) semesters to fulfill the eight (8) hour foreign language requirement for the program.

** **Art Foundations Core Courses** (15 hours required)

*** **Art History Core Courses** (12 hours, including ART 2010 [Art History I] and ART 2020 [Art History II], and three [3] of which must be upper division elective).

**** **Art Studio Core Courses** should be chosen from the following (at least one [1] course must be from two dimensional and one [1] from three dimensional, 12 hours total required):

Two Dimensional: ART 2005 (Drawing II), ART 2112 (Graphic Design), ART 2210 (Painting I), ART 2255 (Introduction to Photography, Digital), ART 2265 (Introduction to Photography, Black and White), or ART 3510 (Printmaking).

Three Dimensional: ART 1310 (Introduction to Sculpture), ART 2350 (Metalsmithing), ART 2410 (Ceramics I), or ART 2420 (Ceramics II).

***** **USP Communication 3.** To be fulfilled with one of the following: ART 4010 (Contemporary Art: Theory and Practice), ART 4600 (Professional Practices & Strategies) or ART 4790 (Seminar).

***** **Art Studio Upper Division Electives** (12 hours required).
