Revolutionizing Nursing Education in Wyoming (ReNEW) is a shared statewide curriculum delivered by nursing programs at all Wyoming community colleges and the University of Wyoming.

The curriculum plan on the following pages is an overview of the ReNEW nursing education program.

PLEASE NOTE:

- Formal admission to a ReNEW community college or university nursing program **is required** to pursue this degree.
- Students who are interested in the ReNEW program should consult with the nursing program at their Wyoming community college.
- Students should not enroll in courses with intention of completing a BSN through ReNEW until they have had direct contact with a Wyoming nursing program and are clear about the ReNEW program requirements and process.

Successful completion of the 3+1 plan requires that a student graduate with the associate's degree in Nursing from his or her respective community college. • This is a guide for course work in the major; actual course sequence may vary by student. Please refer to the online student degree evaluation. • Not all courses are offered every semester and some electives may have prerequisites. Students should review the course descriptions in the catalogs of their respective institutions and consult with their academic advisor to plan accordingly. • Academic plans and course schedules may need to be altered if ACT or Math Placement scores require a student to take pre-college courses (e.g., MATH 0900, 0921, or 0925) before taking required math or English courses.

Eastern Wyoming College requirements:

In order to graduate, students must successfully complete a minimum of 60 credit hours, 15 of which must be applicable towards graduation from Eastern Wyoming College, with a grade point average of 2.0 or better in courses numbered 1000 or higher. • No more than six (6) hours in courses numbered 1490, 1990, 2490, or 2990 will apply toward the degree; in addition, no course offered under the Developmental Studies Department may be applied toward the degree.

University of Wyoming requirements:

Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 to graduate. • Students must complete 42 hours of upper division (3000-level or above) coursework, 30 of which must be from the University of Wyoming. • The ReNEW curriculum satisfies the UW 42-hour requirement if PHCY courses are taken through UW. • Courses must be taken for a letter grade unless offered only for S/U.
