This long-term plan is for LCCC transfer students who choose Early Childhood as their AOC. Courses that will count for AOC include: EDEC 1020, EDEC 1100, EDEC 1300, PSYCH 2300 + FCSC 2122, EDEC 3000, EDEC 3220, EDEC 3220, EDEC 4320, EDEL 3170, and EDEL 2280. Students who choose to minor in Early Childhood Education should take EDEC 1020 and PSYCH 2300 + FCSC 2122 at LCCC before transferring to UW and they should plan to take EDEC 2000 Engaging Families in EC Settings during the summer or during their 3rd year at UW.

This is a guide for course work in the major; actual course sequence may vary by student. • Please refer to the online student degree evaluation. • Not all courses are offered every semester and some electives may have prerequisites. • Students should review the course descriptions in the University Catalog and consult with their academic advisor to plan accordingly.
