Expanding the Canon Classes: Take any two ENGL courses that examine diversity-related issues: for example, postcolonial/ world literature, Native American literature, African-American literature, Latino/a literature, feminist theory, queer theory, disability studies, etc. Examples of these course offerings include ENGL 2340, 2345, 2350, 2360, 3330, 3710, 4450, 4455, 4460, 4470, 4640: Postcolonial Literature, and 4830. Major in English Program Notes:

- A minimum of 120 hours is required.
 - A minimum of 42 hours must be upper division (3000 & 4000 level).
- A minimum of 21 hours of ENGL coursework must be at the upper division (3000 & 4000 level).
- Degree Candidates must meet the academic requirements of the university, and must have a minimum GPA of 2.0 in all courses required for the major.
 - Grades of C or better are required for all prerequisite courses.
 - Students may not take a course for S/U credit to satisfy any requirement, unless the course is offered for S/U credit only.

College of Arts and Sciences Requirements

- Students must take two "core" courses in addition to UW's USP requirements: Diversity in the United States (ASD) and Global Awareness (ASG). These courses may be embedded in the English major.
- No more than 60 hours in the major subject may be used toward the 120 credit hours required for graduation.
- All courses in the major subject must be completed with a grade of C or better.

University of Wyoming Requirements

- Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 to graduate.
- Students must complete 42 hours of upper division (3000-level or above) coursework, 30 of which must be from the University of Wyoming.
- Courses must be taken for a single letter grade unless offered only for S/U.
- University Studies Program (USP), Human Culture (H) and Physical & Natural World (PN) courses must be taken outside of the major subject, but can be cross-listed with the major.

The University of Wyoming Office of the Registrar provides final approval of degree completion requirements prior to the awarding of any degree.
