B.M. Music Education Program Notes:

- A minimum of 120 hours is required.
- A minimum of 42 hours must be upper division (3000 & 4000 level).
- Math, Science & CM Electives must be selected with advisor's approval from Department list. General Electives cannot meet any other requirement for the major. Electives should be selected to satisfy the 42 hour upper division requirement.
- Degree Candidates must meet the academic requirements of the university, and must have a minimum GPA of 2.0 in all courses required for the major.
- Grades of C or better are required for all prerequisite courses.
- MATH 2350 may replace MATH 2200 but student must also have MATH 1405.
- MATH 1405 may be satisfied with Level 5 of the Math placement exam or Math ACT of 27 or SAT Math of 340. Students placing out of MATH 1405 will need an additional general elective.
- Students may not take a course for S/U credit to satisfy any requirement, unless the course is offered for S/U credit only.
- Elementary Class Piano 1-2 is highly recommended for students with little or no piano experience. All BME Brass, WW, and Percussion majors must either pass the Piano Literacy test OR Class Piano 1 & 2 with a B or better during their sophomore year.

College of Arts and Sciences Requirements

- Students must take two "core" courses in addition to UW's USP requirements: Diversity in the United States (ASD) and Global Awareness (ASG).
- No more than 60 hours in the major subject may be used toward the 120 credit hours required for graduation.
- At least 30 hours in the major subject must be completed with a grade of C or better (individual majors may require more).

University of Wyoming Requirements

- Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 to graduate.
- Students must complete 42 hours of upper division (3000-level or above) coursework, 30 of which must be from the University of Wyoming.
- Courses must be taken for a single letter grade unless offered only for S/U.
- University Studies Program (USP), Human Culture (H) and Physical & Natural World (PN) courses must be taken outside of the major subject, but can be cross-listed with the major.

The University of Wyoming Office of the Registrar provides final approval of degree completion requirements prior to the awarding of any degree.
