### Sociology Program Notes:

- Students pursuing a B.A. in Sociology must fulfill USP and college requirements listed in the UW Catalog, satisfy required prerequisites to courses in the major program and complete a minimum of 34 credit hours in the major. Only courses in which a grade of C or better has been earned to satisfy major requirements.
- Thirty-four (34) hours are required to earn a B.A. in Sociology. The 34 hours in Sociology includes 13 hours of Foundation courses, 12 hours of Core courses and 9 hours of electives. Grades of C or better must be earned in all 34 hours of coursework that may be used toward the major.
- **Quantitative:** See the "Prerequisite and MPE Cut Score Reference Chart" on the Math Placement website for the most up-to-date math placement equivalencies: <http://www.uwyo.edu/mathstats/math-placement/>.
- **SOC Elective:** Additional courses from the Sociology Core courses list can satisfy this requirement; however, there are other options available.
- The ASD requirement may be fulfilled by SOC 2350, SOC 3500, or SOC 3640 in Core courses. If one of these courses is not selected as one of the 4 Core Sociology courses or as a sociology elective, students must fulfill ASD with an additional course.
- Sociology majors have the option to take a sociology course to meet the ASG requirement.

### College of Arts and Sciences Requirements

- Students must take two "core" courses in addition to UW's USP requirements: Diversity in the United States (ASD) and Global Awareness (ASG).
- No more than 60 hours in the major subject may be used toward the 120 credit hours required for graduation.
- At least 30 hours in the major subject must be completed with a grade of C or better (individual majors may require more).

### University of Wyoming Requirements

- Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 to graduate.
- A minimum of 120 credit hours is required. Students must complete 42 hours of upper division (3000-level or above) coursework, 30 of which must be from the University of Wyoming.
- Courses must be taken for a single letter grade unless offered only for S/U.
- University Studies Program (USP), Human Culture (H) and Physical & Natural World (PN) courses must be taken outside of the major subject, but can be cross-listed with the major.

The University of Wyoming Office of the Registrar provides final approval of degree completion requirements prior to the awarding of any degree.
