This is a guide for course work in the major; actual course sequence may vary by student. Please refer to the online student degree evaluation, and consult with an academic advisor. • Not all courses are offered every semester and some electives may have prerequisites. Students should review the course descriptions in the *University Catalog* and consult with their academic advisor to plan accordingly.

University of Wyoming requirements:

Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 to graduate. • Students must complete 42 hours of upper division (3000-level or above) coursework, 30 of which must be from the University of Wyoming. • Courses must be taken for a letter grade unless offered only for S/U. • University Studies Program (USP) Human Culture (H) and Physical & Natural World (PN) courses must be taken outside of the major subject, but can be cross-listed with the major.

College of Arts and Sciences requirements:

Students must take two "core" courses in addition to the USP requirements: Diversity in the United States (ASD) and Global Awareness (ASG). • No more than 60 hours in the major subject may be used toward the 120 credit hours required for graduation. • At least 30 hours in the major subject must be completed with a grade of C or better (the major may require more).

Art History Program Notes:

The Bachelor of Arts in Art History requires a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA and a minimum 2.5 GPA within the major to graduate.

- A minimum of 51 hours within the art major are required for graduation.

Art History Program Notes con't:

* A **single language** must be taken for four (4) semesters to fulfill the 15 hour foreign language requirement for the program. • Students taking American Sign Language to fulfill the language requirement of the major will have to take other courses to fulfill the USP H requirements.

** Six (6) hours of **Art Foundation Core** courses can be chosen from the following: ART 1005 (Drawing I), ART 1110 (Two Dimensional), ART 1120 (Three Dimensional), or ART 1130 (Color Theory).

*** Three (3) hours of **Art Studio Core** courses can be chosen from the following: ART 1310 (Introduction to Sculpture), ART 2005 (Drawing II), ART 2112 (Graphic Design), ART 2210 (Painting I), ART 2255 (Introduction to Photography, Digital), ART 2265 (Introduction to Photography, Black and White), ART 2350 (Metalsmithing), ART 2410 (Ceramics I), ART 2420 (Ceramics II), or ART 3510 (Printmaking).

**** Eighteen (18) hours of upper division art history electives are required. This includes:

- Six to nine (6-9) hours of upper division art history courses, six (6) hours of which may be taken in other departments with cross listed courses; these may include: AMST 4250 (The Harlem Renaissance), AMST/ART 4640 (Art and Ecology), ANTH/ART/HIST 2700 (Introduction to Museology), ARE 3030 (History of Architecture), ART/WMST 4780 (History of Women Artists), ART/WMST 4830 (Victorian Women's Lives), HIST 4075 (Book History: Manuscripts), HIST 4076 (Book History: Printed), HIST 4077 (Book History: Topics) and Special Topics in American Studies and Special Topics in Modern and Classical Language, including travel courses as appropriate.
- Six to nine (6-9) hours of ART 4790 (Art Seminar)
- Three to nine (3-9) hours of "Other Historical Traditions," examples of which include but are not limited to: ART 3720 (Art and Architecture of Medieval Islam) or courses offered as Special Topics or Seminars (e.g. Japanese Art & Culture and Meso-American Art).
