College of Arts and Sciences requirements:

Students must take two "core" courses in addition to the USP requirements: Diversity in the United States (ASD) and Global Awareness (ASG). • No more than 60 hours in the major subject may be used toward the 120 credit hours required for graduation. • At least 30 hours in the major subject must be completed with a grade of C or better (the major may require more).

Theatre & Dance, Musical Theatre Concentration Program Notes:

This degree program permits a total of 60-70 credits in the major. It is designed primarily for students who seek additional professional training in theatre and dance or who wish to enter MFA graduate programs. • Participation in the London Semester or a study abroad program is recommended. Please consult with an academic advisor.

* **Dance Elective.** A total of three (3) hours should be selected from:

- THEA 1410 (Ballet I/I)
- THEA 1430 (Modern Dance I/I)
- THEA 1450 (Beginning Tap Dance)
- THEA 1480 (Beginning Jazz)

** The department recommends that a foreign language be taken to fulfill UW's general studies human culture (H) requirement. However, if American Sign Language is taken, other courses will need to be identified to fulfill the H requirement.
