This is a guide for coursework in the major; actual course sequence may vary by student and is subject to change. Please refer to the online degree evaluation, and consult with an academic advisor. • Academic plans and course schedules may need to be altered if Math Placement scores require Math 0900, 0921, or 0925. • Not all courses are offered every semester and some electives may have prerequisites. Students should review the course descriptions in the *University Catalog* and consult with their academic advisor to plan accordingly.

### University of Wyoming requirements:

Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 to graduate. • Students must complete 42 hours of upper division (3000-level or above) coursework, 30 of which must be from the University of Wyoming. • Courses must be taken for a letter grade unless offered only for S/U. • University Studies Program (USP) Human Culture (H) and Physical & Natural World (PN) courses must be taken outside of the major subject, but can be cross-listed with the major.

### College of Business requirements:

A 2.50 grade point average is required in all College of Business courses to graduate. • A 2.50 grade point average is required in all UW courses for Advanced Business Standing and graduation. • 50% of business credit hours must be from UW. • A grade of C or above required for common body of knowledge and major specific core courses. • A maximum of six (6) hours of freshman/sophomore-level military science and a maximum of six (6) hours of junior/senior-level military science may be applied to degrees in the College of Business.

### Notes:

• Upon declaring a major in the College of Business, students are expected to comply with the requirements of AACSB International (the Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business), the University of Wyoming, and the College of Business.

\* Component of Advanced Business Standing. • This represents only a portion of the total components required for Advanced Business Standing.

\*\* Requires MATH ACT  $\geq 23$ , MATH SAT  $\geq 600$ , Math Placement Exam  $\geq 3$ , or  $\geq C$  grade in MATH 0925.

\*\*\* Common Body of Knowledge or Major Specific Core. • This represents only one course of the total Common Body of Knowledge requirements. The remaining courses require Advanced Business Standing.
