Students should review course descriptions in the *University Catalog* and consult with their academic advisor to plan accordingly.

University of Wyoming requirements:

Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 to graduate. • Students must complete 42 hours of upper division (3000-level or above) coursework, 30 of which must be from the University of Wyoming. • Courses must be taken for a letter grade unless offered only for S/U. • University Studies Program (USP) Human Culture (H) and Physical & Natural World (PN) courses must be taken outside of the major subject, but can be cross-listed with the major.

Haub School of Environment and Natural Resources requirements:

This is an interdisciplinary degree housed in the Haub School of Environment and Natural Resources (ENR), and all students interested in the BS in Outdoor Recreation and Tourism should consult with an advisor in ENR. • This degree requires students to select a concentration as an area of focus (minimum of 21 hours). The concentration will be selected from a list of pre-approved areas and with guidance from the student's academic advisor.
