Why Recruit at UW?

1. **Variety:** Over 12,000 UW students pursue **80 undergraduate** and over **90 graduate** academic programs. This exposure means students have access to diverse course offerings, ensuring that they are well educated, both inside and out of their areas of expertise.
2. **Classroom Experience:** Student to world-class faculty ratio is a highly accessible **15:1**, and **76%** of professors have the highest degree in their field. **92%** of classes are taught by professors, with only 8% led by grad students.
3. **Work Ethic:** UW graduates are consistently complimented by employers for their willingness to go the extra mile. Students are instilled with **Western ethics** that translate exceptionally to the business world.
4. **Campus & Community Leadership:** Over **250 campus organizations** and countless volunteer opportunities allow students to get involved outside the classroom. Students frequently not only lead their fellow students but make a positive impact on their community and the world.
5. **Global Perspective:** UW is committed to the goal of **25% of students studying internationally by 2025**. That opportunity, along with a large international student population from over **90 countries**, makes our students adaptable to diverse work situations.
6. **Hands-on Work Experience: Internships, jobs, and/or research opportunities** are available in all of our departments. Our goal is to provide employers with well-rounded graduates who adapt easily to diverse workplace environments.
