GPS: 1401 E Fraternity Row, Laramie, WY 82071 (This will get you close to the Wyoming Student Union Parking Lot)

From U.S. 287: Turn east onto E Grand Ave and continue until 15th Street where you will turn left (north). Turn left (west) at E Fraternity Row into the large Union Parking Lot for FREE parking.

From I-80: Take exit 316 for I-80/US-30/Grand Ave. Continue on Grand Ave. until 15th Street where you turn right (north). Turn left (west) at E Fraternity Row into the large Union Parking Lot for FREE parking.

Parking Information:

So we can better assist you, I recommend that you park at the Wyoming Student Union (www.uwyo.edu/tour) which is off of 15th Street. Starting at 8:00 a.m., I will have staff meet and greet you in the union parking lot and show you the way to the West Atrium Classroom Building.

Parking permits are not required on the weekend, and metered parking is not enforced. However, parking is enforced 24 hours a day, 7 days a week in yellow zones, fire lanes, spaces marked by the universal disability access symbol, "U" parking, reserved parking, and "R".
