



Transfer, Non-traditional and Veteran Student Orientation June 7 or 21, 2017

TO-DOS BEFORE COMING TO ORIENTATION

- ✓ **Log in to WyoWeb**
 - Go to wyoweb.uwyo.edu and login. If you have never logged in before, choose "Obtain Username and Initial Password".
 - Complete every required action item on your interactive checklist.
 - **Before you are able to register for classes, you must complete the following:**
 - Pay your enrollment deposit (must be paid before you can register for orientation),
 - Send in your MMR vaccination records,
 - Submit official transcripts to date for every college/university you have attended, even if it was only for one class or you withdrew/failed.
 - Upload a picture for your WyoOne Student ID (this may take a few days to upload, so please plan ahead and do this early), and
 - Take your math placement exam, if necessary.
- ✓ **Obtain copies of transcripts from each college/university you have attended.**

THINGS TO BRING:

- ✓ **Transcripts.** Bring a copy of your transcript from your current college/university and transcripts from all other colleges/universities you have attended even if you have already sent us one. Unofficial copies will work.
- ✓ **Current class schedule if taking summer school courses.**
- ✓ **Immunization Record showing two MMR vaccinations.** You are not able to register for classes if your Immunization Hold has not been lifted. Your hold is cleared if there is a green checkmark on your WyoWeb account next to the MMR verified.
- ✓ **Wear comfortable shoes!** You'll be walking to various locations on campus.

PARKING AT UW

There is FREE parking in the Ford Stadium Lot located behind the Marian H. Rochelle Gateway Center (222 S. 22nd Street).

Metered and permit parking is not recommended. If you have a handicap placard and plan to use it during your visit, please call us at (307) 766-4075 to discuss parking details. UW Admissions is not responsible for any parking citations for this event. Please park wisely.

From I-80: Take exit 316 for I-80 Bus/UW 30/Grand Avenue. Continue on Grand Avenue until 22nd Street where you will turn right (north). Turn left (west) into the Ford Stadium Lot just behind the Marian H. Rochelle Gateway Center, which is on the corner of 22nd and Grand Avenue. There is FREE parking in the Ford Stadium Lot. If you get to the stop sign at Willett Drive and 22nd, you have gone too far.

From US 287: Turn east onto E. Grand Avenue and continue to 22nd Street where you will turn left (north). Turn left (west) into the Ford Stadium Lot just behind the Marian H. Rochelle Gateway Center, which is on the corner of 22nd and Grand Avenue. There is FREE parking in the Ford Stadium Lot. If you get to the stop sign at Willett Drive and 22nd, you have gone too far.

GETTING TO THE WYOMING UNION

Walking: Go to the south side of the Marian H. Rochelle Gateway Center to Grand Avenue. Go right (west) on Grand Avenue to 13th Street. Turn right (north) on 13th Street and walk toward the circle north of Ivinson Street. The Wyoming Union is on the right at the top of the circle.

Shuttle: The Shuttle is free. From the east side of the Marian H. Rochelle Gateway Center, take the westbound Campus Commuter Shuttle to the stop in the Wyoming Union parking lot (second stop). The Union is located just east of the parking lot. The shuttles runs approximately every 10 minutes. You can download the bus tracking app at <http://uwyo.transloc.com/info/mobile>.
