FAFSA

- Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
 - \bullet FAFSA on the web $\underline{www.fafsa.ed.gov}$
 - Student and parents must have a FSA ID
 - If you have not yet completed the FAFSA for this upcoming year, its not too late
 - 2016 tax information is needed for the for the 2018-19 school year
 - Must reapply every year 2019-20 opens October 1, 2018
 - Many foundation scholarships require the FAFSA to be completed to be considered for a scholarship



Financial Aid awards scholarships, grants, loans and work study

- Financial aid packages are created once the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) has been received
- An email is sent to the student UWyo email address
- · Missing requirements are listed within student portal







Federal Work Study

- Based on the results of the FAFSA and application date (not all students will be awarded or eligible)
- Typical award is \$3,000 per year = 10 -15 hours per week
- Minimum wage or higher per hour to work on campus
- Usually flexible with your hours
- Opportunity to gain experience in a specific field
- There are other non Federal Work Study opportunities on campus
- These positions also pay minimum wage or higher and are on campus



Student & Parent Loans

Federal Direct Student Loans

- Subsidized Interest paid by the government 5.05%
- Unsubsidized Student is responsible for all interest 6.60%
- There are maximum amounts student may borrow

Parent Loan for Undergraduate Student (PLUS)

• Either parent can apply & is based on a credit review 7.60%

Private/Alternative Loans

• Student applies with a credit worthy co-signer

Satisfactory Academic Progress

SAP = requirements for maintaining federal aid

- The process is generated at the end of every semester (also summer)
- 2.0+ cumulative GPA
- Bachelor's Degree in 180 attempted hours
- Complete 67% of all classes

SAP = requirements for maintaining institutional scholarships

- 3.0 cumulative GPA
- Please make sure your student is aware of what is needed to keep federal aid as well as scholarships.
