



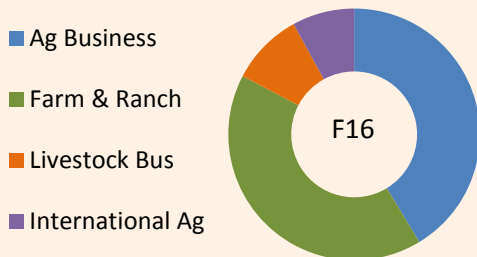
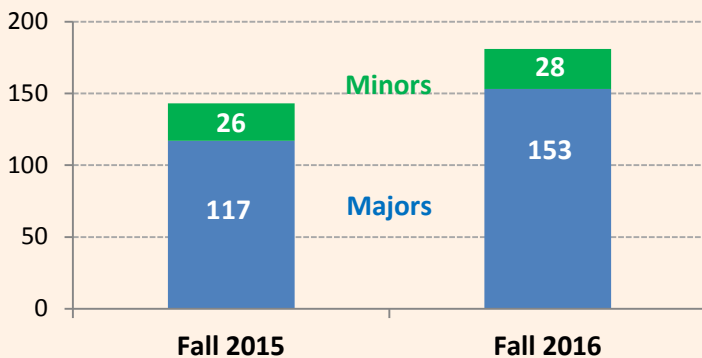

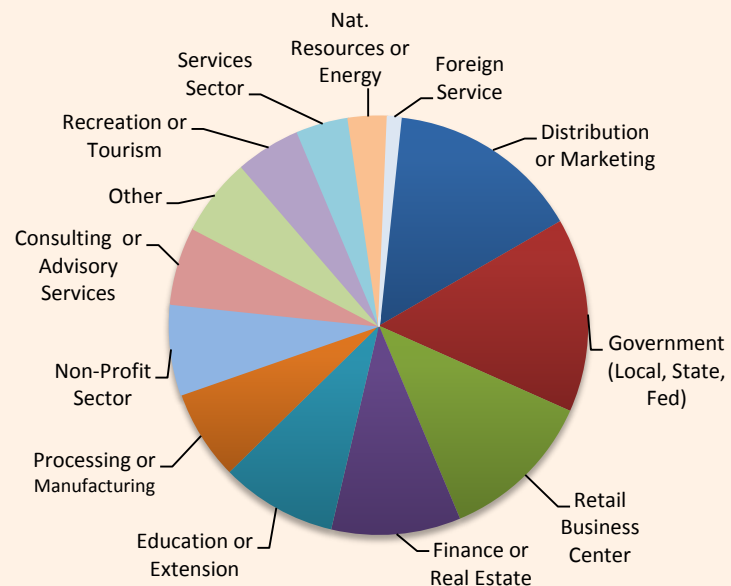
## AGEC STUDENTS

- ✧ **High School GPA & ACT Scores**
  - H.S. GPA (AGEC)  $\geq$  College & UW avg since 2012
    - H.S. GPA average = 3.55 (2015)
    - ACT Composite average = 23.3 (2015)
- ✧ **Career Success**
  - 94% of AGECE majors get FT jobs in area of study
  - Median earnings with B.S. in AGECE = \$60,000
  - 46% future jobs in Ag = Business/Management

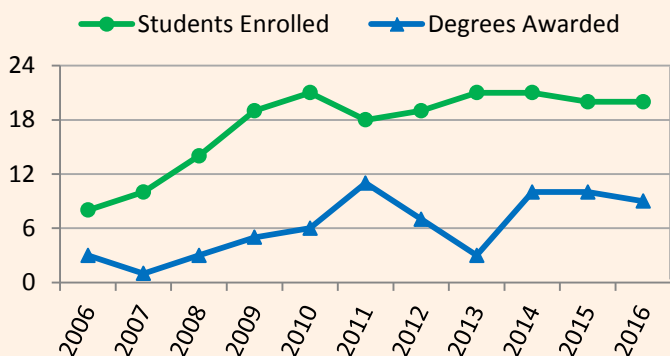
## AGEC UNDERGRADUATE TEACHING

- ✧ **Faculty & Staff**
  - 13 Faculty + 5 Extension/Research Scientists
- ✧ **Teaching**
  - 80 credits of undergrad coursework per year
    - 2,048 student credit hours in 2015-16
  - 82% of classes taught by tenure-track faculty
  - 75% of courses in 2016 were 80-100% full
  - 60% of course enrollments are by non-majors
  - 25 years leading students (125 thus far) to France
  - 21 awards/nominations for teaching & advising

  - 100% of classes taught by tenure-track faculty
  - 55% of students funded with extramural dollars
