Parking Information

Parking permits are NOT included in the registration fee.

Day Permits

We recommend purchasing a day permit for Friday, October 21 to use while on campus. Day permits can be purchased as a printable online permit or a hard copy scratch off permit. The fee for a day permit is \$7.00 per day and allows you to park in gold, brown, orange, red, purple or green zone parking spaces. Day permits do not allow for parking in reserved spaces or metered spaces. Parking in an accessible parking space is allowed with a day permit only when the appropriate state/city disability placard or license plates are displayed. There is a FAQ located at the website above that provides more detail regarding the printable online permit and the hard copy scratch off permit to determine which option may be best for you. The hard copy scratch off permit can be purchased in-person at UW Transit and Parking Services at the off-campus address noted above. The Wyoming Union Information Desk, located on the first floor, does sell the hard copy scratch off permit as well for \$8.50. Permits are not valid for game day parking. A campus parking map can be found on the UW Parking and Transit website.

Shuttle Service

The Express shuttle departs every 10 minutes running from 6:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. The Express shuttle services the South (15th and Spring Creek) and East (30th and Willet) Park 'N Ride lots and the Union. The Link shuttle departs every 20 minutes running from 6:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. and two of the stops included are the Marian H. Rochelle Gateway Center and the Union. Shuttle map routes are available at the link above. Riders on all fixed-route buses need to request their stop by pulling the yellow cord in each bus thirty seconds before they would like to exit.
