THIS YEAR'S FIELD SCHOOL WILL INCLUDE WORK AT A POSSIBLE MAMMOTH KILL SITE, SURVEY ALONG THE EAST SIDE OF THE BIGHORN MOUNTAINS, AND EXCAVATION OF A DEEP ROCKSHELTER IN THE BIGHORN BASIN. REQUIRES CAMPING AND OUTDOOR LIVING IN BEAUTIFUL COUNTRY.
