- WHEREAS, there are over 5,000 University of Wyoming students
- on federal financial aid; and
- 3 WHEREAS, proposed financial aid cuts in Congress would
- 4 eliminate the student loan interest subsidy, campus-based aid
- 5 programs (including Supplemental Grants, Perkins Loans, and
- 6 Work Study), and the State Student Incentive Grant program;

- 8 WHEREAS, proposed financial aid cuts would result in a 20%
- 9 increase in loan payments for undergraduates; and
- 10 WHEREAS, the proposed cuts would increase loan payments for
- graduate students by 30%; and
- WHEREAS, the proposed cuts would mean a loss of \$1 million in
- financial aid at the University of Wyoming; and
- 14 WHEREAS, the proposed cuts would mean a loss of 360 student
- jobs at the University of Wyoming; and
- 16 WHEREAS, borrowing at the University of Wyoming will increase
- from \$20 million to \$25 million; and
- WHEREAS, the proposed cuts would lead to severe reductions in
- 19 services to students, most importantly in library and computer
