

SENATE BILL #1822

Title: Increase in ASTEC (Associated Students Technical Services) Billable Rates

Date: September 12, 1996

Sponsors: Senators Anthes, Curry, Donelan, Plemmons, Wilson & Young

1 WHEREAS, on October 1, 1996, the Federal minimum wage will increase from \$4.25 to
2 \$4.75 an hour, and on September 1, 1997, it will further increase to \$5.15 an hour; and
3 WHEREAS, training and specialization has historically led wages for ASTEC employees to be
4 higher than the minimum wage; and
5 WHEREAS, recent policy changes negated payment from Recognized Student Organizations
6 for ASTEC services and resulted in increased student fee support; and
7 WHEREAS, ASTEC will become more independent from student fees with the proposed
8 increase in billable rates;
9 THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students of the
10 University of Wyoming that on July 1, 1997, the billable rate of ASTEC technicians per hour
11 be raised from \$6.00 to \$7.00 per hour for Recognized Student Organization events; and
12 THEREFORE, be it further enacted that the billable rate per hour be raised from \$6.00 to
13 \$8.00 per hour for all other events.
