

SENATE RESOLUTION #1836

Title: Meal Plan Rate Increase

Sponsors: Senators Evenson, Khan, McFarland, Plemmons and Schanck

1 WHEREAS, University Food Service is not currently funded by State monies and is  
2 therefore required to be self-sustaining; and

3 WHEREAS, there have been no major renovations done on the Washakie Food Center  
4 since 1960; and

5 WHEREAS, infrastructure deteriorations have become increasingly worse, causing  
6 nearly \$500,000.00 worth of damage to the deck adjoining the residence halls; and

7 WHEREAS, the federal government recently passed legislation raising the current  
8 minimum wage; and

9 WHEREAS, the cost of the Plus Money Program currently outweighs the benefits.

10 THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Student Senate of the Associated Students of the  
11 University of Wyoming, that we support the following increases in meal plan rates for  
12 the fall semester of 1997: Unlimited Access 1.3%; Any 15 Access 1.875%; and Any  
13 12 Access 2.95%.

14 THEREFORE, be it further resolved by the Student Senate of the Associated Students  
15 of the University of Wyoming, that we support a 50% decrease in the amount of plus  
16 money given to each meal plan.
