

SENATE RESOLUTION #1838

Title: Housing Fee Increase

Date: November 18, 1996

Sponsors: Senators Evenson, Khan, McFarland, Plemmons and Schanck

1 WHEREAS, over the last one and one-half years, the Department of Housing has
2 suffered nearly \$700,000.00 in reductions in mineral reserve money from the State of
3 Wyoming; and

4 WHEREAS, currently Hill Hall, Crane Hall, and the Spanish Walk Apartments are
5 operating in a deficit budget; and

6 WHEREAS, the infrastructure of the Washakie Complex is in dire need of repair; and

7 WHEREAS, staff has been reduced to a bare minimum; and

8 WHEREAS, students would rather see the current services continued and a slight
9 increase in costs, than to see a reduction in services. (See Addendum).

10 THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Student Senate of the Associated Students of the
11 University of Wyoming, that we endorse a 6.5% increase in the Residence Fee in
12 White Hall, Orr Hall, McIntyre Hall, Hill Hall, Crane Hall, Downey Hall, and the
13 University Apartments; and

14 THEREFORE, be it further resolved, that we endorse a 7.0% increase on specialty
15 floors.
