1 WHEREAS, the Homecoming football game for 1997 is scheduled for September 20,
2 1997; and

3 WHEREAS, Homecoming is traditionally scheduled for later in the semester; and

4 WHEREAS, student fees help fund athletic events; and

5 WHEREAS, students' experience with Homecoming encompasses involvement in student-
6 organized activities in addition to the football game; and

7 WHEREAS, in order to properly put together many of these events requires a time period
8 longer than three weeks; and

9 WHEREAS, many student organizations do not have their new membership for the
10 following school year in the spring prior to that school year; and

11 WHEREAS, by organizing Homecoming events for Fall '97 in the Spring of '97 eliminates
12 the involvement of new members of student organizations who traditionally help plan these
13 events; and

14 WHEREAS, Alumni who travel to attend the football game and these events also
15 traditionally expect a date later in the fall.

16 THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Student Senate of the Associated Students of the
17 University of Wyoming, that we do not support the decision to have the 1997 Homecoming
18 football game on September 20, 1997.
