Title: Creation of ASUW Student Appointment Board

1. WHEREAS, the current process by which students are appointed to University boards
2. and committees lacks collaboration; and
3. WHEREAS, the current process by which students are appointed to University boards
4. and committees lacks sufficient organization, cohesion, and clarity; and
5. WHEREAS, there is no system of informing students about University boards and
6. committees; and
7. WHEREAS, ASUW does not currently advertise or reach out to students broadly to
8. advertise positions available on university boards and committees; and
9. WHEREAS, no system of accountability exists for students appointed to serve on
10. University boards and committees; and
11. WHEREAS, student representation on University boards and committees is critically
12. important for the overall governance of the University; and
13. WHEREAS, student representation on University boards and committees increases
14. student involvement opportunities on campus.
15. THEREFORE, be it enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students of the
16. University of Wyoming (ASUW) that an ASUW Student Appointment Board be
17. created through the changes to the ASUW By-Laws outlined in Addendum A; and
18. THEREFORE, be it further enacted that ASUW adopt and implement the

19. recommendations outlined in the report included as Addendum B.

ASUW Bylaws Article I.2.A.1.a-c		<p>1. Student Appointment Board</p> <p>a. <u>Purpose</u>. The purpose of the Board shall be to assist in the process of selecting students to serve on University boards and committees.</p> <p>b. <u>Powers</u>. The Board shall have the authority to recommend students to serve on University boards and committees. The ASUW President, with the approval of the ASUW Senate [see ASUW Bylaws Article II.4.G] possesses the final authority to appoint or, in some cases, to recommend student appointments to the appropriate University authority. The Board is responsible for appropriately advertising vacant</p>

		<p>and available student positions on University boards and committees. The ASUW Secretary is responsible for maintaining a database of students appointed to serve on University boards and committees. Appointed students are to report to the Board a minimum of one time per semester.</p> <p>c. <u>Composition</u>. The Board shall consist of all ASUW ex officio members approved by the ASUW Senate (excluding ASUW Executive Assistants, Student Activities Council, and Concerts and Convocations), one (1) ASUW Senator, and one (1) student at large. The ASUW President serves as chairman and appointing authority for the Board.</p>
