

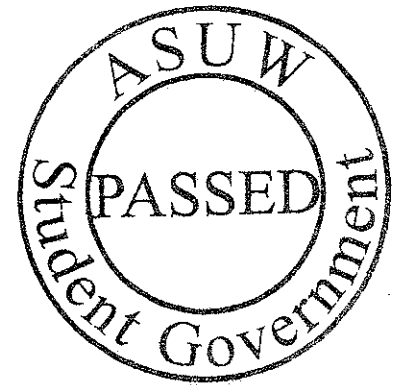
SENATE RESOLUTION #2272

TITLE: Half Acre Expansion at the University of Wyoming

DATE: February 19, 2010

AUTHORS: Senators Brown, Cusack, and Mullen

SPONSORS: Senators Dugas and Fournier; and Vice President Hunzie



1. WHEREAS, the Half Acre facility is an important asset to the University of Wyoming; and
2. WHEREAS, Half Acre serves as a central location for student activities and services; and
3. WHEREAS, Half Acre has not been updated since 1999; and
4. WHEREAS , the University has made a significant commitment to finding other funding
5. Sources; and
6. WHEREAS, recent Associated Students of the University of Wyoming (ASUW) research
7. has shown that students support student fees funding Half Acre renovations and expansion;
8. and
9. WHEREAS, the Half Acre expansion committee and University of Wyoming administration
10. has recommended a minimum student fee increase of \$60 per fall and spring semester, and
11. \$45 per summer semester not to be implemented until FY14.
12. THEREFORE, be it resolved by the ASUW that the ASUW supports a minimum student fee
13. increase of \$60 per fall and spring semester, and \$45 per summer semester not to be
14. implemented until FY14.
