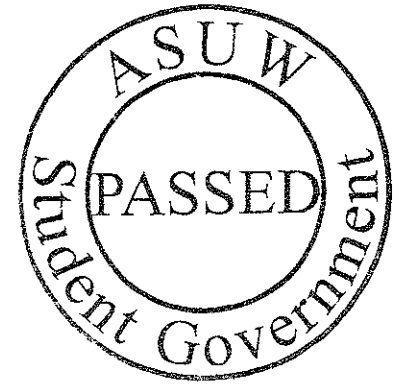


SENATE RESOLUTION #2281



Title: Support for Laramie-Wide Wireless Access

1. WHEREAS, the Academic Information Technology Committee of the Faculty Senate of the
2. University of Wyoming (UW) has passed a resolution supporting Laramie-wide wireless
3. access; and
4. WHEREAS, many of the university's operational and educational systems, such as WyoWeb
5. and eCompanion, are now digitally-administered; and
6. WHEREAS, internet and UW network access for students, faculty, and staff would
7. dramatically enhance educational opportunities and community connectivity; and
8. WHEREAS, access to such a network would be limited to students, faculty and staff; and
9. WHEREAS, the cost to the students of such a proposal would be nominal; and
10. WHEREAS, there is substantial UW community support for Laramie-wide wireless access.
11. THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming
12. (ASUW) that the ASUW supports Faculty Senate efforts to implement their proposal for
13. Laramie-wide wireless access; and
14. THEREFORE, be it further resolved that, upon Faculty Senate approval of such a proposal,
15. the ASUW Senate's Academics and Technology, Student Interests and Policy Planning, and
16. Student Relations Committees, in coordination with and at the discretion of the Faculty
17. Senate, should be obligated to review and provide recommendations to the ASUW Senate for
18. ASUW-sponsored funding legislation to aid in the implementation of the Faculty Senate's

19. Laramie-wide wireless initiative.
