**Programmatic Fees:** The Revenue Enhancement Committee is finishing up their report specifically regarding the possible implementation of programmatic fees and making it public Friday of this week. I will get the formal proposal later this week as well and distribute it to the Senate as well as starting on the creation of legislation for it to present to Senate to get the official stance on the students to bring to the Board of Trustees.

Additionally, it was suggested by Advisor Snyder, who is another point of contact, to attend the Diversity Strategic Planning Committee listening sessions to express comments and concerns over how the university plans to address its issues of diversity.
  - **-The Good Mule Fall Conference-** Aside from participating/supplementary leading the fall edition of the Good Mule, I will be coming up with projects, topics, and discussions for the Good Mule Project in the spring. Weekly facilitator meetings will be set up after October 19<sup>th</sup>. I am open to any and all suggestions from ASUW and encourage the Senate to register once that becomes available.
- Projects/ Goals for the upcoming week.
  - **-UMC Collaborations:** UMC's first campaign will be about cultural appropriation, in particular in Halloween costumes. I will be attending the educational series and their next roundtable, which will be happening next Wednesday, October 12.
  - **-MLK Days of Dialogue:** After attending the committee meeting on Tuesday, I will be serving on at least three subcommittees and facilitating support for the conference through the use of RSOs, like Partners of the Americas and the Multicultural Association of Student Scientists, as well as programs, like the Good Mule Project facilitators. Heavy planning for the conference will begin once subcommittee chairs and calendar details are determined.
