3. Alliance) be allocated \$785.00 to help finance the cost of
4. a semi-formal dance that is scheduled for April 29, 1977.
5. The breakdown for the expected expenses is as follows:
6. Advertising                   \$ 150
7. Band contract                600
8. Room & janitorial       35  
  costs
9. Total                           \$ 785
10. Any revenue generated will apply to the above amount, any
11. excess will be split on a 50/50 basis by ASUW and the BSA.
12. Ticket prices will be set at \$2 per individual and \$3 per
13. couple.
