1. Be it enacted by the Student Senate of the Associated Students of the
2. University of Wyoming that \$928.94 be allocated to the Laramie Lacross Club
3. to provide for equipment. The funds will be allocated as follows: \$395.00
4. for 10 helmets with full cage, \$48.00 for one pair of goal nets, \$59.90
5. for 2 goalie sticks, \$154.00 for 6 attack/midfield sticks, \$79.50 for 3
6. defense sticks, \$39.00 for 6 replacement handles, \$225.00 for 10 pairs of
7. gloves and \$32.25 for 3 boxes of balls at \$10.75 per dozen. Money will
8. constitute a one time expenditure.
