Justification for Senate Resolution #1260

The University is spending over 2 million dollars to add an upper deck to the east side. The University spent over 1.5 million to add an upper deck to the west side in 1969. The University is currently seeking \$25,000 to study replacing the temporary seating at the ends of the stadium. At this time the physical plant is scheduled to repaint the fiberglass seats this summer. These seats were just repainted five years ago.

Repainting is a very short term attempt, which at this time, because of the advanced state of splintering, has no guarantee of stopping the splintering for even one year. The University is spending large amounts of money on the football stadium without making any plans for replacing the seats in the student body section for at least another two years.
