Thesis: Changes in parking permit system

1. Be it resolved by the Student Senate of the Associated Students of the
2. University of Wyoming that we request the following changes be made in
3. the parking system. 1) "A" permits be issued only to faculty, staff and
4. other University employees who: A) reside outside the current 'F' permit
5. area or B) have valid reasons (other than disabilities) for needing to
6. drive to work. 2) "F" permits be issued only to those students in Greek
7. Housing thus students living off campus in a 6 block radius from core campus
8. (circle drive around Prexies) would no longer receive a parking permit.

RE: Veto of Senate Resolution #1282

I am reluctantly vetoing Senate Resolution #1282 for the following reasons.

I think we're going in the right direction but there should be more work on this proposal. As the resolution stands, I see it as unfair to students who reside within the current "F" permit area, especially those who are not connected with the fraternity or sorority system, but reside within six blocks of main campus.

I feel the bill should be equal to all including faculty, staff, and students. Line 5 of Senate Resolution #1282 allows for exceptions to faculty and staff but not students. I would hope you would either remove the exception of faculty and staff or include students.

In addition, I feel there should be some definition of valid reasons and designate who will decide those reasons.
