2. University of Wyoming that a new ad hoc committee on consumer rights be
3. established to provide a single vehicle through which students can
4. address those problems dealing with education at the University as a
5. consumer product. It is understood that the creation of this ad hoc
6. committee will serve as a prelude to the future establishment of a
7. standing committee in accordance with the Constitution and By-Laws of
8. the ASUW.
