3. to encourage instructors to select required textbooks that are reasonably
4. priced as well as effective tools of instruction. For example, Paper Books
5. Publishing could be utilized and instructors could use the same text for
6. more than just one semester. This type of attitude will reflect on the
7. University as being genuinely concerned with the needs of its students.
8. Furthermore, this may encourage competitive pricing policies by the publishers.
9. This can only be accomplished through administrative awareness.
