3. highly motivated students often take as many courses within a curricula

6. recognition for such in-depth academic concentration and whereas a Cross
7. College Major would not substitute for the double major in that the double
8. major is within the same college; be it resolved by the Student Senate of
9. the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming that we support the
10. concept of a Cross College Major. The Cross College Major would enhance
11. the marketability of both the student and the University.
