Title: Intramurals

Introduced: March 12, 1984

Thesis: Student fee support for Intramurals

2. Intramural Office is without a firm financial base, and whereas the loss
3. of an Intramural program would greatly harm the environment of the student
4. body; therefore, Be it resolved by the Student Senate of the Associated
5. Students of the University of Wyoming that the ASUW support and urge the
6. Trustees to add on an additional \$2.50 per semester student fee for the
7. purpose of maintaining the present Intramural program. This fee allocation
8. would be overseen by a committee made up of administrators and students
9. and would take effect in the Fall of 1984.
