Title: Approval of Uni-Reg changes and new Uni-Regs

1. Whereas the University of Wyoming has the responsibility to provide
2. resident instruction, extension education, service, and research to the
3. people of Wyoming; and whereas the "Students have the right, as well as the
4. obligation to play a significant role in guiding their university," (from
5. preamble of ASUW Constitution) and whereas the adoption of a new UniReg or
6. the change of an existing UniReg has the potential of altering the academic
7. environment at the University of Wyoming; be it resolved by the Student
8. Senate of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming with regard
9. to the academic environment of the University of Wyoming and welfare of
10. students that we request an addition to UniReg 1, paragraph 4-APPROVAL AND
11. EFFECTIVE DATE that states: No UniReg, or change or addition to an already
12. existing UniReg, may become effective without the approval of the student
13. government of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming within a
14. two week period. Copies of this resolution shall be sent to the University
15. of Wyoming President and each Board of Trustee member.
