Title: Audio taping of ASUW Constitution, By-Laws and minutes of government meetings

1. Whereas the student government of the Associated Students of the University
2. of Wyoming seeks to provide an effective organization to represent the
3. concerns of the student body, and whereas we recognize there are students
4. who are sight impaired or rely on audio reinforcement to normal visual
5. learning, and whereas the Constitution, By-Laws, resolutions, bills, and
6. minutes of student government meetings should be available to all students
7. on the University of Wyoming campus, and whereas the student government
8. wants to improve the communication between itself and all students of the
9. University of Wyoming campus, therefore, be it resolved by the Student
10. Senate of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming have
11. recorded on cassette tape the Constitution and By-laws of the ASUW; and
12. therefore that provisions be made that resolutions, bills and minutes of
13. ASUW meetings be recorded within 27 hours if so requested for use by
14. students who are sight impaired. These tapes could be checked out by
15. students from the ASUW Office. Tapes will be kept on file for not more
16. than one year.
