Title: Infants and Toddlers at the Top?!

1. Whereas there is a critical concern at the University of Wyoming for
2. retention and enrollment; whereas ASUW attempts to answer the needs of
3. their representative students; whereas there is a significant and
4. increasing number of non-traditional students; whereas these said students
5. have documented and quantified needs for child care services; whereas other
6. Wyoming community colleges (ex: WWC, LCCC, NWCC) have met these needs with
7. child care programs-principally funded within by same colleges; whereas
8. since 1978 continued efforts for the establishment of child care have been
9. largely ignored; be it resolved by the Student Senate of the Associated
10. Students of the University of Wyoming that ASUW compel the University
11. administration and Board of Trustees to recognize said need and initiate an
12. expansive beneficial child care program. Be it further resolved that ASUW
13. heartily endorse and distribute the CURE sub-committee report (drafted by
14. Judith Powell, Head of Home Economics Dept. and Margaret Cooney, Coor-
15. dinator of UW Child Care Center) dated January 6, 1987, to the University
16. administration, the Board of Trustees and any interested public.
