11. given to the ASUW president and vice president no later than 1 week prior
12. to the last day of finals of the spring semester. Be it further resolved
13. that the ASUW president and vice president be requested to report all
14. information pertinent to the aforementioned objectives to the ASUW Senate
15. no later than the 2nd regular Senate meeting of the fall semester.
