SENATE RESOLUTION #1576

Title: Support of Tuition and Athletic Fee Increase

Introduced: September 15, 1987

Sponsors: Jaimie Bright, Jim Egan, Greg Rothmeyer, Ramin Taheri

1. Whereas the current level of University of Wyoming funding cannot be
2. sustained for the 1988-1990 biennium without a recommended increase in
3. tuition, and whereas not increasing tuition would likely result in a
4. decrease in the programs and services now offered by the University of
5. Wyoming, and whereas the University of Wyoming has the lowest tuition
6. for a major comprehensive university in the region and the proposed
7. increase in tuition would not change this fact, and whereas the students
8. of the University of Wyoming recognize the necessity to maintain the
9. present quality of education; therefore, be it resolved that the Student
10. Senate of the Associated Students of the University of Wyoming support
11. the proposed increase of \$20.25 per semester for in-state tuition and
12. \$74.50 per semester for out-of-state tuition. Be it further resolved
13. that the Student Senate of the Associated Students of the University of
14. Wyoming support the \$2.75 per semester athletic fee increase.
