Title: "Celebrate the Student Family Month"  
Introduced: October 20, 1987  
Thesis: Recognition of \*non-traditional students on the University of Wyoming campus.  
Sponsors: Jennifer Gras and Joe Max Flores

1. Whereas there are many University of Wyoming college students between
2. the ages of 18-24 that are either married and/or have children; and where-
3. as there are 3200 students enrolled at the University of Wyoming who are
4. 25 years of age or older; and whereas the population of non-traditional
5. students at the University of Wyoming make up more than 35% of the total
6. student enrollment; and whereas international trends show that the
7. majority of student enrollment will eventually consist of non-traditional
8. students, therefore be it resolved by the Student Senate of the Associ-
9. ated Students of the University of Wyoming that the month of November be
10. recognized as "The Student Family Month."

\*Be it known that a non-traditional student is defined as a student between the ages of 18-24 who is either married and/or has children, or a student 25 years of age or older.
